1. Plan

Describe the methods that will be used to protect all ductwork, supplies, returns, and exhaust ductwork during construction as well as the methods of documentation. **Open grates, scrap wood, or metal plates without some kind of air impenetrable material as a sealer below are not acceptable. Air impenetrable sealants can include a taped down piece of Tyvek, sticky sided plastic, or taped down sheet plastic, etc.**

2. Documentation

Photographs and on-site verification along with the final accountability form. Video is also acceptable.

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
